BEFORE THE SESSION · ESTATE AUDIT

Azure Migrate discovery

Optional. Servers, VMware, SQL, apps — inventory, dependencies, sizing.

Fill the gaps

CMDB exports and owner interviews where tooling can't reach.

Existing Azure footprint

Tenant, network, identity, and policy captured if you already run in Azure.

Scope confirmed

First-wave candidates agreed with owners — the room plans, not discovers.

WHAT YOU GET

Six artifacts, ready to execute.

01 Scoped Migration / Modernization Assessment

Every in-scope workload with a confirmed disposition, right-sized target, and readiness blockers named.

03 Landing Zone Design · Network & Services

Hub-and-spoke or Virtual WAN, address plan, hybrid connectivity, firewall, private endpoints and DNS, and system placement.

05 Wave Plan & Detailed Roadmap

Waves sequenced by dependency and value, method and owner per wave, cutover and rollback, and Wave 1 dated.

02 Landing Zone Design · Tenant & Subscriptions

Management groups, subscription model, naming and tagging, and platform-as-code — at build-ready depth.

04 Governance & Operations Specification

Identity and RBAC, Azure Policy, Defender, Backup and Site Recovery, monitoring, and cost guardrails — by role, against the Well-Architected pillars.

06 Run-Cost, TCO & Funding

Azure run-rate with Hybrid Benefit and reservations applied, a roadmap TCO, and Microsoft funding arranged for qualified accounts.

HOW IT WORKS

Six blocks. Roughly 9 to 4, with a working lunch.

01 · MORNING

Audit Review & Scope

Walk the estate audit, confirm each disposition, lock the scope.

02 · LATE MORNING

Tenant & Subscription Design

Management groups, subscriptions, naming, platform-as-code — new, or your existing zone hardened.

03 · MIDDAY

Network & Service Design

Topology, address space, hybrid connectivity, firewall, private endpoints — and where each system lands.

04 · EARLY AFTERNOON

Governance & Operations

Identity, Policy, Defender, HA / BC / DR, monitoring, and cost controls — by role.

05 · MID AFTERNOON

Waves & Methods

Group workloads into waves; pick the method per wave — Azure Migrate, AVS, database migration, AKS or PaaS.

06 · LATE AFTERNOON

Roadmap, Sizing & Funding

Dated roadmap, effort sizing, run-cost and TCO, funding path, and the Wave 1 start date agreed.
